ZONING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- Scaled drawing of site indicating accurate boundary of the premises, adjacent property and public streets, alleys and easements.
- Location, size and use of all existing and proposed buildings dimensions showing setback distances from all property lines, separation distance between all buildings.
- Paved area and number of off-street parking on site
- Storm water drainage
- Location and size of existing utility service lines and their entry points
- Location and size of existing storm and sanitary sewer lines and water lines and their point of connection.
- Size type and location of all signs and sign structures.
- Parking space sizes are: 10 ft. by 20 ft, except ,parallel space is 8 ft. by 23 ft.; industrial spaces are 8 ft. by 20 ft.
- Complete Set of Plans Approved by State of Ohio.

Loading and Unlaoding spaces are required on premises used for manufacturing, storage, warehouse, goods displayed, department store, wholesale store, market, retail store, hotel, hospital, laundry, dry cleaning or other use involving the receipt or distribution, by vehicles, of material or merchandise. The loading space shall be 10 feet wide, twenty feet long and be unobstricted for a height of fourteen feet, except in B-3 Zoning Districts where the length shall be increased to twenty-four feet.
